## **News from The Treasurer**

You may remember that I gave a presentation last November in which I predicted that we would overspend by just short of £10,000 in this financial year to October, unless things changed.

The good news is that things have changed.

Thanks to all of you who have responded, either with new or increased standing orders or specific gifts. Assuming things continue more or less as they are, we will have a much more healthy outcome. Regular income has increased by some £4,700 per annum in addition to which there have been a number of individual donations, one of which was substantial.

We are keeping this large gift to one side for the moment because it is important to see how we fare without it since we should aim to be able to sustain the Church by routine giving. Nonetheless, it is a very welcome fall back in case of need, and I expect to draw on some of it this year.

As at the end of April, half way through the financial year, we have overspent £2,200 but that is better than my prediction by nearly £8,000 at this stage, before we get some Gift Aid back.

I did say 'make me stand here next year and confess my prediction was wrong'. You're doing it.

Again, Thanks All; we are now pulling together more than before.
